

**Rocky River Middle School

FEES

GRADES 6, 7 & 8	\$55.00 for basic school fees that include student plan book and general supplies
8 th GRADE PHYSICAL SCIENCE	\$15.00 general fee for all 8 th grade students enrolled in Physical Science for High School Credit.
WORLD LANGUAGE	\$20.00 Spanish 8 workbook \$30.00 Spanish 7 and Spanish 1 workbook \$30.00 French 8 and French 1 workbook
FITNESS	\$18.00 for gym uniform (\$9.00 shirts/\$9.00 shorts) if a student does not already have a uniform.
ATHLETICS	\$55.00 for students involved in each athletic team to cover the costs of bus transportation. PAYMENT OF THIS FEE IS DUE AT THE BEGINNING OF EACH ATHLETIC SEASON TO RRMS MAIN OFFICE OR ONLINE THROUGH EZ PAY.

PLEASE MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO ROCKY RIVER MIDDLE SCHOOL

*Any student enrolled in Algebra I and Honors Geometry will need to have a Texas Instruments TI-84 Plus CE graphing calculator. We recommend the TI-84 Plus CE if you are purchasing for the first time. These can be purchased by the student for approximately \$118.00. If you want to **lease a graphing calculator from the school, it will be a TI-83 and it will cost \$20.00 when you pay school fees.** The student is responsible for the calculator and it must be returned in working order. If the calculator is not returned in working order or in the same condition as it was leased, the student will be responsible for replacing the calculator by either paying \$100.00 towards a replacement or supplying a like calculator to the school.

Since the student will be using this calculator for their classes in high school, we recommend that each student purchase their own calculator. It is essential that your child permanently mark their calculators with their name in case it is lost/stolen.

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
